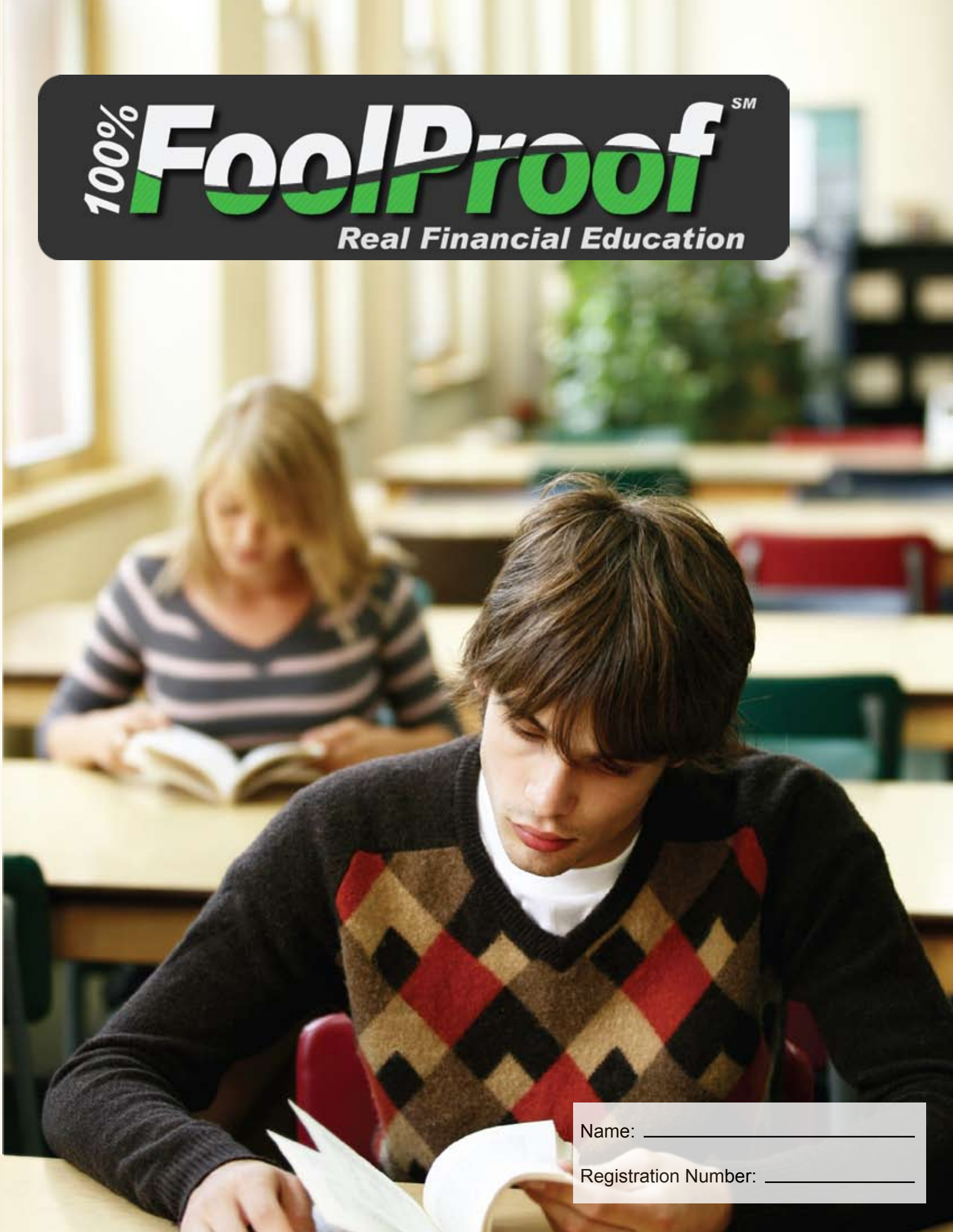

FoolProof for High Schools is a highly interactive, self-grading group of online lessons called “modules”. The modules teach young people about money, financial responsibility and the realities of the free enterprise system.

Consumer advocacy: FoolProof was developed by consumer advocates, teachers and students, not by marketers. We believe our messages are the messages you would want to deliver to your own kids.

State standards: FoolProof’s core modules meet most state financial literacy standards. Our online website shows you what standards we currently

meet in your state. Upcoming modules will meet even more standards.

Engaged students: FoolProof’s modules feature audio and video clips, music and game breaks. All material is geared toward the high school student, and, just as important, delivered by young people not much older than your students. Our presenters talk “to” your high school students, not “at” them.

Many classroom sessions: The core FoolProof modules take the average student about ten 45-minute classroom sessions. There are five modules and two additional homework modules.
